### OA policies are complex

(e.g. Which publications are covered by the policy?)

### Uploading the wrong version of a publication causes delays

(Faculty members aren't sure what version of the article to upload)


### Faculty are busy people

(so they forget to deposit publications)

### OA policies alone do not guarantee adoption

(still lots of typing and form filling)

## How do we help?



Open Access policy

Use this page to determine which publication types are included in your Institutional Open Access Policy and from what date. You can also set up policy exclusions based on when the user started at the institution and whether an embargo or waiver has been requested for a publication. These settings will determine which publications fall within your OA policy to allow for on-screen reminders to submit to the repository, the option of 'claim-plus' on the pending page and the configuration of email notifications.






